Year 2 Curriculum Information - Spring Term

Oceans and seas.

Maths

In maths this term we will be covering

- Number and place value
- Addition and subtraction using an number line
- Multiplication and division fluency
- Fractions
- Problem solving/reasoning
- Measurements

Literacy

To start our topic we will be sailing across the oceans and as we become ship wrecked we will be writing S.O.S letters, a shipwrecked story in chapters. We will also be learning about Titanic and writing historical reports based on information we will research. We will be continuing to practise cursive handwriting and some children will start to join their handwriting.

Phonics

Children will continue to learn the spelling rules in Phase 6 along with using suffixes and prefixes. Some children will continue to be exposed to Phase 5 however they will also now be introduced to Phase 6 too.

Please look out for new information regarding how spellings are tested.

Topic (Geography/History)

First of all we will be naming the oceans of the world and labelling them on a world map. We will then look at the history of boats and significant sea explorers. We then progress onto researching about Charles Darwin. Later in the term we will be researching the Galapagos Islands and the discoveries Darwin made.

RE

This term our focus in RE is on Sikhism. We will be looking at how Sikhs worship different Guru's, what the Guru Granth Sahib' is and where Sikhs worship.

PE

In outdoor PE we will be focusing on net and wall games. Children will explore how to send and receive a ball over a net in order to play a net games. Indoor PE will focus on children learning Bhangra dancing to tie in nicely with our topic in RE.

Music

Children will be starting to learn the recorder. They will also be using tuned and un-tuned instruments to create music with a beat.

Art

Children will find out about Turner and his stormy paintings. Children will also be colouring mixing as well as using paint to show shades of secondary colours. Following on from that, children will be making their own sea themed glove puppet. They will be designing, making, sewing and evaluating their puppets.

Science

Children will be investigating and testing different materials to find out their properties and uses. We will also test to see how absorbent and water proof they are. Children will also find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. Children will also explore healthy eating.

PSHE

This term children will be thinking about rights and responsibilities as well as scenarios where children have to think about what is right and wrong.

Computing

Children will be taking photographs and editing them using various programs.
