Our Wonderful World

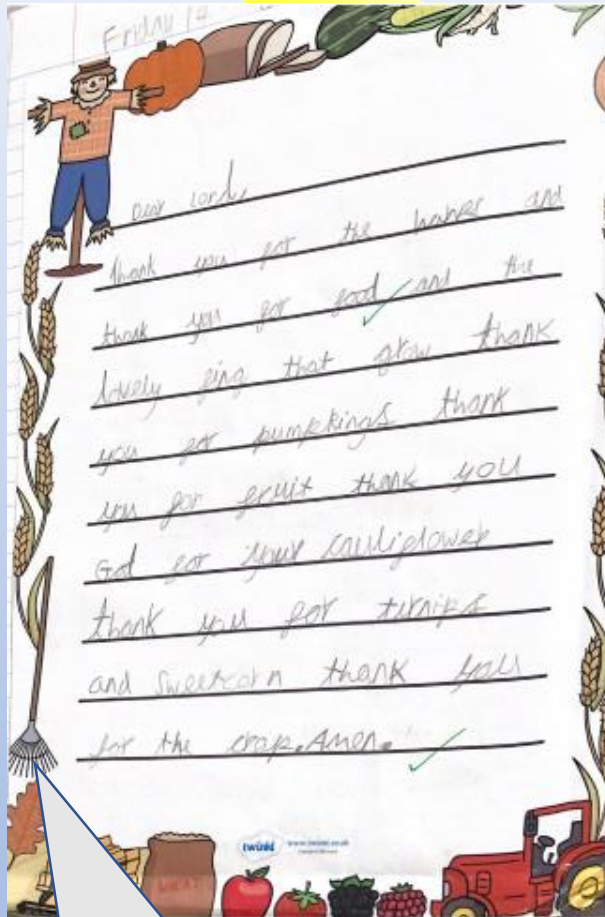


The best thing about our world is:

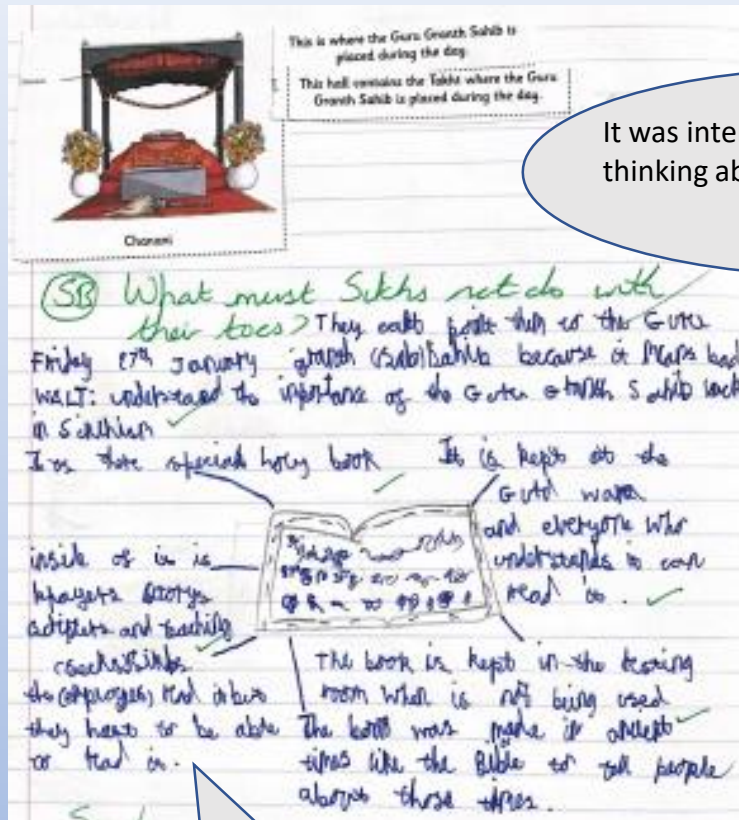
The sunset going down.

My favourite piece of work is...



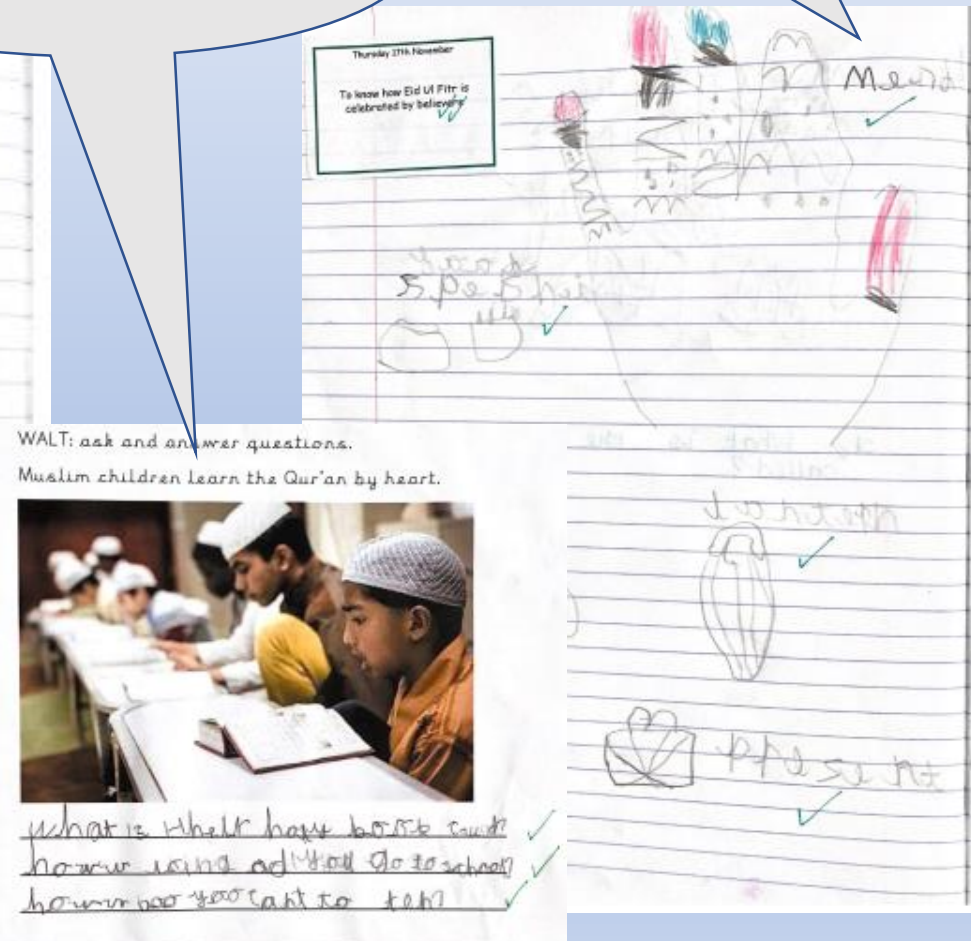
Writing the harvest prayer, it reminded me about the farmers and made me think about the farmer we met in Science last year. Y1
