Vocal Group

Weekly co-curricular activity every Tuesday with Mrs Lowe. Opportunities beyond this such as visiting Choir of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra



Community Singing

Visits to the wider community such as care homes and taking part in the annual lights switch on in the village.



Rocksteady

Co-curricular Music club, where children are in band within mixed year groups (from Year 1 to Year 4). 3 performances each year to parents, which sees around 85 parents engage in this opportunity every term.



Peripatetic Lessons

Children engage weekly with a Music specialist for a 30 minute lesson that focuses on learning to play an instrument and to read Music. At St Nicholas, this is flute, guitar, violin, and keyboard.



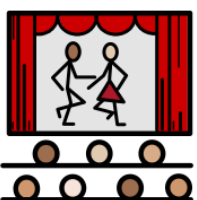
Specialist Music Teaching

KS1 and KS2 adopt a hybrid model to teaching the Music curriculum that involve learning led by the class teacher and at least a term of a specialist Music teacher.



Musician of the Month

A focused musician for the whole-school each month, that reflects a range of composers and artists, and musical styles.

A 2-yearly annual show that provides children across the school with an opportunity to showcase their music talent to a wider audience.
